The LKLP Community Action Council, Inc. provides Community Collaboration for Children program services (CCC). The CCC program includes intensive, short term, In-Home Based Services for low-risk families or permanent caregivers or guardians with children in the home for birth to age 5 and for families with children to age 18 designed to prevent child abuse and neglect.

CCC services are provided in the eight county Kentucky River Area Development District including Wolfe, Lee, Breathitt, Owsley, Perry, Knott, Leslie, and Letcher counties.

The LKLP CCC program seeks to develop, support, empower, and strengthen the families receiving CCC services by teaching problem solving skills, discussing appropriate discipline techniques, assisting parents in becoming self-sufficient and coordinating available community resources.

These services must include: assessments and curriculum lessons utilizing the Nurturing Parent Quiz (pre and post CCC services) from the evidence-based Nurturing Parent Curriculum, by Stephen J. Bavolek, Ph.D..

Following the assessments, the LKLP CCC Caseworkers provide referrals for community resources and begin the appropriate lessons from the curriculum to achieve jointly developed goals.

CCC Services

- Assessments of age appropriate development for children 12 months to 5 years
- Parenting skills assessments
- In-home based parenting skills assistance from evidence-based curriculum, the Nurturing Parent by Stephen Bavolek
- Assist clients with scheduling and obtaining transportation, locating funds, goods, and services while improving parenting skills as needed to strengthen families and safely maintain children in their own homes.
- Optimum timeframe for CCC Services no less than eight weeks or longer as needed to reach goals.



How to Receive CCC Services or Make a Referral

Referrals are accepted from Community Partners, the Department of Community Based Services and self-referrals.
