Low-Income Board Member Eligibility

- Reside in the county you wish to represent and be at least 18 years old
- Be either low-income **OR** represent low-income residents
 - Income at or below 200% of the current Federal Poverty Guidelines, **OR**
 - Represent a low-income organization or community group
- Able to participate actively in the development, planning, implementation, and evaluation of LKLP Community Action Council, which includes the CSBG Program

- Attend bi-monthly Full Board Meetings held in Perry County or virtually
- Attend Board Committee Meetings quarterly or as needed
